

HUTCHISON PORTS SIGNS EXTENSION AGREEMENT WITH RAK PORTS IN THE UAE

In April 2025, Hutchison Ports RAK and RAK Ports signed an extension agreement to provide container terminal services at Saqr Port, the largest bulk-handling port in the Middle East, until 2037.

Sheikh Saud bin Saqr Al Qasimi, Supreme Council Member and Ruler of Ras Al Khaimah emphasised, 'ports are an essential element of Ras Al Khaimah' s (RAK) logistical infrastructure, serving as vital gateways for trade and economic prosperity.' Building on this momentum, the ongoing collaboration between Hutchison Ports and RAK Ports aims to unlock further connectivity across key Asian markets, reinforcing the port's role as a strategic trade enabler in the wider region.
